The West Central Airshed Zone, includes the western edge of Edmonton to the B.C. border, including Drayton Valley, Violet Grove, Breton, Tomahawk, Carrot Creek, Genesee, Hinton, Edson, Thorsby and Pigeon Lake. Thanks to the ongoing support of the agricultural community, electrical utilities, oil and gas producers, forestry and coal sectors, health providers, our local Municipalities, and the Provincial Government, we have the ability to demonstrate that our air continues to be fresh, clean and safe. The West Central Airshed Society is a non-profit organization that has been monitoring the air quality for the region, with the support of numerous industries and government organizations since 1995. We currently operate 12 ambient air monitoring stations and 14 passive air monitoring stations. Our 12 ambient air monitoring stations continuously broadcast live data via the West Central Airshed Society website, in an easy to read format that includes hourly updates for sulphur dioxide, nitrogen oxide, particulate matter as well as wind speed, direction and temperature.
